- STEP #3 Answer 3 questions:
 - 1. What does this say about God?
 - 2. What does this say about humanity?
 - 3. What is the Holy Spirit prompting me to do?
- STEP #4 Pick where & when you'll meet next time, then enjoy hanging out together!
